The City

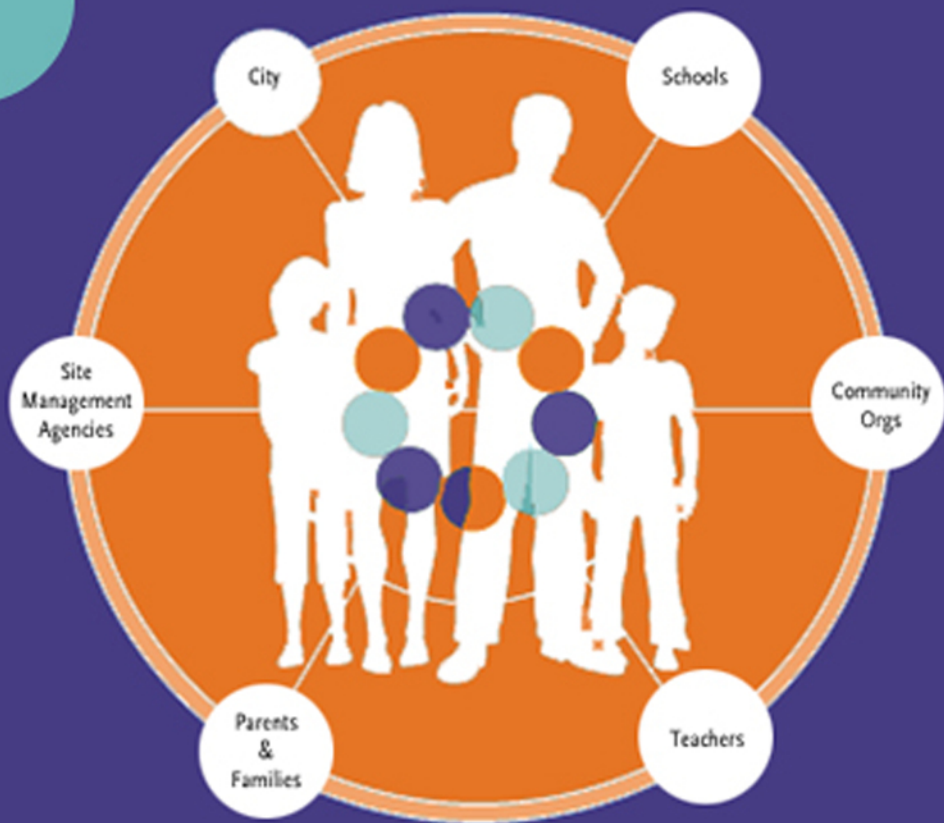
Includes a line item in the annual budget dedicated to supporting PASA's after-school systems. The Mayor sits on PASA's Board of Directors.

The School District & Schools

Contributes in-kind support in the form of transportation and facilities. The Providence Public School District has a data-sharing agreement with PASA to maximize student impact.

Community-Based Organizations

PASA partners with over 70 community-based organizations who provide programs as part of the AfterZone and Hub systems.



Teachers

School day teachers partner with PASA to offer programming in the AfterZone and the AfterZone Summer Scholars, where they engage in collaborative professional development and instruction with community-based educators.

At the Hub level, teachers participate as teachers-of-record for ELO (expanded learning opportunities) students, ensuring their work is credit-worthy.

Parents and Youth

PASA collects ongoing program feedback from participating youth in the form of surveys. We included parents in the design of the AfterZone and regularly conduct outreach.

Site Management Agencies

PASA's SMA partners handle the day-to-day logistics of running each AfterZone middle school site.
